
Sequencer



Classic team problem-solving task



Sequencer is a classic team problem-solving task that is well known to many experiential trainers. Our version of this classic activity requires the group to construct the 15 unmarked pieces according to the 2-dimensional 'Sequencer' diagram supplied.

Sequencer can be used with groups of 6 to 16 people, and typically takes around 45 minutes. Use it to see how the groups can improve team performance under increasing pressures!

Sequencer requires close co-operation, strong leadership and excellent communication skills between members, as well as a clear allocation of team roles. Following the initial stage 1 construction period the group then have to re-assemble the pieces against the clock - can they produce sufficient process improvement in stage 1 to achieve the challenging stage 2 time trial?







Sequencer comes in 3 sizes:

- Standard sealed plywood version Maximum single piece length: 122cm (48 inches) Supplied with wheeled plastic shipping container
- Tabletop sealed plywood version Maximum single piece length: 91cm (36 inches) Supplied with carrying case and bag
- Mini lightweight sealed plywood version Maximum single piece length: 61cm (24 inches) Supplied with shipping tube
